Description:

Help and advice is available to ALL students but students with Moderate Learning Difficulties (sometimes known as Complex Needs), Severe and Profound Learning Difficulties, Autistic Spectrum Disorder, Physical Impairment, Sensory Impairment, and those attending residential schools, including out of area schools, receive additional support. A specialist Learning Difficulties and Disabilities Team (LDD) team work with young people with additional needs up to 25 years of age. Advisers are present at Year 9 Transition Reviews in all schools. Parents of all Y9 students with a statement will be contacted by letter explaining the role of a careers adviser, the purpose of the Transition Review, specialist further education colleges and the Disabled Students Allowance.

Client group intended for:

13 – 25 years of age, for young people with Learning Difficulties or Disabilities.

13 – 19 for other young people.

There is also an 'all age' service
