The team works, Monday to Friday 9am-5pm.

The Learning Disability Nurses provide holistic advice and support regarding the following areas: Assessing Need; Challenging Behaviour; Child Development; Communication; Continence; Epilepsy; Family Support; Health Screening and Promotion; Medication management; Prevention of Health Problems; Sensory Impairment; Skills Development; Sleep Advice and Assessment; Puberty and Growing Up.
