Create Project

Description: Northorpe Hall has received funding from Lloyds TSB for a new creative arts project supporting children and young people with learning disabilities.

The Create Project will use a variety of creative mediums, including movement, music, drama and art, to allow children and young people to freely express themselves. We will offer two weekly sessions during term time, one for children aged 8-11 and one for young people aged 12-16, each lasting 1 hour 30 minutes. The groups will take place in The Barn at Northorpe Hall, providing a relaxing and comforting environment for the sessions and each session will offer space for up to 18 participants.

- For workers to identify any additional need and support families to access appropriate support services

Sessions will provide the opportunity to explore specific issues effecting children and young people in a non threatening environment, such as bullying, personal safety, friendship, relationships and sexual health. The group will aim to work towards an annual performance, which will be devised by the group, and will be open to the public to attend.
