Child Tax Credit	An allowance for parents and carers of children or young people who are still in full-time education. You may get extra if you care for a disabled child. See 'What you'll get' for more information.
Disabled Facilities Grants	Grants to help pay for adapting your home by installing a ramp, lift or other improvements.
Blue Badge Parking Scheme	The <u>Blue Badge scheme</u> provides a range of parking benefits for disabled people with severe walking difficulties who travel either as drivers or as passengers.
Vehicle Tax Exemption	You can apply for exemption from paying vehicle tax if you get the: • higher rate mobility component of <u>Disability Living Allowance (DLA)</u> • enhanced rate mobility component of <u>Personal Independence Payment (PIP)</u> The vehicle must be registered in the disabled person's name or their nominated driver's name. It must only be used for the disabled person's personal needs. It can't be used by the nominated driver for their own personal use.
Vehicle Tax reduction	You can get a 50% reduction in the cost of your tax disc if you get the PIP standard rate mobility component.
