



## **A warm welcome to PCAN's Information Festival!**

Please have a read through the following information to ensure you have a smooth arrival and enjoyable morning.

### **Parking**

There are a number of parking spaces at Cliffe House and there will be a person at the entrance gate who will be able to direct you towards available parking. If there are no parking spaces left on site, please follow the one-way system to the exit of Cliffe House and find an on street parking space. Please be aware that parking is not permitted on the main A629 road. If you have booked a disabled parking permit you will have already received this with instructions

### **If you have children booked into childcare:**

The childcare for children is taking place in the Coach House which is the building on your right as you enter the entrance driveway to Cliffe House. On arrival, please go the Coach House to check your child/children in. Please ensure that they have everything they need with them to make their stay enjoyable.

### **Booking in:**

Please go to the tent situated outside the main entrance to Cliffe House where you will be greeted by volunteers from PCAN, wearing green sashes.

### **What's going to happen at the festival:**
